Rutgers School of Nursing, in partnership with Camden County College in Blackwood, NJ, is excited to offer an opportunity to obtain a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing (BSN) after completion of an Associate Degree in Science – Pre-Nursing or related track. Students applying to the 2+2 program must possess either an Associate of Science degree or sixty (60) undergraduate prerequisite credits. This program offers:

- Admission to the Rutgers School of Nursing upper divisional academic nursing program
- Student services & support programs administered through Rutgers University – New Brunswick
- The opportunity to complete all coursework, taught by full-time Rutgers University School of Nursing faculty, at the Camden County College – Blackwood Campus
- Clinical experiences in the Southern New Jersey/Greater Philadelphia area

Get started towards a meaningful career

Admission Criteria:

- Full consideration given to applicants with a minimum GPA of 3.0 or above (Preferred GPA of 3.3 or higher)
- Preferred grade of “B” or higher in the following courses: Anatomy & Physiology I and II, Chemistry I and II, Microbiology, and English Composition I and II
- Student must complete the HESI A2 exam, and obtain an overall score of 80% in order to be granted full admission.
- Must enroll and complete a CPR course, and earn the Basic Life Support Certification (BLS) prior to entry into the 2+2 program. Students may opt to enroll in the 1-credit HPE-181 course at Camden County College if they do not possess a current certification.
- Students may only have one science course, either Microbiology or Chemistry II, incomplete at the time of application.
- Students are responsible for ensuring that prerequisite coursework is transferable to Rutgers University School of Nursing. Students applying from NJ community colleges may use NJTransfer.org for assistance.

Admissions Process:

The Summer application will be available **September 1 - February 1** on the Rutgers University Undergraduate admissions website.

Program Requirements:

This is a full-time program that requires a considerable commitment for class, clinical attendance, and academic preparation.
